


IMPORTANT: Weight limit is 15 lbs. evenly distributed.

Temporarily Mounting Mic Bar into Ceiling Tile Using Brackets

1. Slide ceiling tile over to expose the ceiling.



2. Place mounting bar onto ledge in ceiling. The result should look like the illustration below.




3. Slide ceiling tile back into place.

Note: You may need to cut a small amount of the ceiling tile for it to fit back into place due to the bracket.


Permanently Mounting Mic Bar into Ceiling

1. Hold bar to ceiling. Take the included wood screws, and screw them through the holes into the ceiling. Illustration below shows the screw going into the hole.

Note: You will need to find studs and/or use proper hardware depending on your application.



2. After inserting the two screws, the final result should look like the illustration below.



Note: Use the hook and loop straps on the ceiling bar for cables.
